

PROTOCOL FOR STUDENTS APPLYING TO AND VISITING HWS

Early Childhood Students:

Preschool/ Kindergarten students may be asked to visit for a morning from 7:55 am – 12:00 pm (half day). You may drop off as early as 7:15 am. A school snack will be provided in the morning. Please bring a water bottle and a blanket/ snuggle item for nap time. A change of clothes is also recommended. Shoes are required.

Lower School Students (Grades 1 – 8):

Students may be asked to visit in the classrooms up to three consecutive days and are expected to do the work that the other students in the class are doing, to the best of their ability, including homework assignments.

Students, please:

- Wear appropriate clothing for running, climbing, and playing. Clothes should be free of
 media and advertising images. Also, you should have a pair of closed-toe shoes at school
 every day, either with a back-strap or completely enclosed. Closed-toe shoes are
 mandatory for daily visits to the largest backyard.
- Bring a "brown bag" healthy lunch with something to drink, water recommended. Also, a
 little healthy snack for morning recess. <u>Refrain from bringing any sugary foods like candy,
 soda and juices.</u>
- Movement classes occur throughout the week. Bring appropriate attire to change into if needed. (T-Shirt, Shorts and Tennis Shoes).
- Mobile phones may not be used at any time on our school campus. If a phone is needed, please come to the school office.
- On the first day of visiting, check-in at the office at 7:45 am. Parents, please complete a Student Visitor form with emergency contact information.
- Dismissal is at 2:45 pm EXCEPT Wednesdays, which is at 2:00 pm. Parents or designated drivers may either park across the street from the school and pick up their visiting student(s) at the garden/pedestrian gate, or may drive through the parking lot drop-off/ pick-up area.
